Through a comprehensive continuum of services, Civic Heart supports youth, families, and individuals through prevention education, workforce development, housing stability, health access, justice diversion, mentoring, and community-based programming. Our work is rooted in evidence-based practices, cultural responsiveness, and partnerships that strengthen both individuals and the neighborhoods they call home.

Each year, Civic Heart serves thousands of Houstonians across Harris and surrounding counties by addressing the challenges that limit opportunity while also building the skills, resources, and relationships that help people thrive long-term.

At Civic Heart, we believe lasting change happens when people are empowered, communities are supported, and opportunity is within reach for all.





OUR PROGRAMS



Youth Prevention

Rescue Youth Program

Delivers evidence-based drug prevention education focused on life skills, character development, anti-bullying, and healthy decision making, equipping youth to resist substance use and make positive choices.

Bright Minds Thrive Program

Provides out of school, community-based activities for youth in Harris County that promote engagement, leadership, and positive social development in safe, structured environments.

Teens Making A Choice Program

Provides evidence based teen pregnancy prevention education to students in grades 9 through 12, focusing on healthy relationships, responsible decision making, and future goal setting.



Youth Mentorship

VOICES 2.0

Provides self discovery and life skills sessions for girls at risk of justice involvement using evidence based curriculum. The program focuses on decision making, emotional regulation, goal setting, and positive identity development. Participants also receive individualized case management and supportive services to strengthen stability, accountability, and long term success.



Economic Mobility & Self Sufficiency

Working HEARTS Program:

Provides workforce development services to low income and disadvantaged individuals residing in Harris County, equipping participants with job readiness skills, training, and support needed to secure employment and achieve long term self sufficiency.

Father's First Program:

Promotes healthy relationships, responsible fatherhood, and economic mobility by equipping fathers with the tools, education, and support needed to strengthen families and increase financial stability.

RIM 2.0 Program:

Providing permanent supportive housing to chronically unshoused persons ages 18+ referred from the Homeless Coalition's coordinated access point. Participants receive case management, furnished dwelling, rent and utility support and supportive services for reacclimating for independent living.



Health & Wellness

HIV Prevention & Wellness Program

Provides confidential, free testing for adults 18+ in Harris County, along with prevention education and linkage to care to improve early detection and community health outcomes.

Helping Hands Program

A breast and cervical cancer prevention initiative providing education and resource referrals to women 18+, promoting awareness, early detection, and informed health decisions.



Health Coverage & Benefits

ACA Navigator Program

Provides free assistance to individuals and families in Harris and surrounding counties to access affordable health coverage through the ACA Marketplace. Trained Navigators guide consumers through plan selection and enrollment each year to ensure continued access to care.



Financial Readiness & Homeownership

Community Connection Program:

Provides comprehensive homebuyer preparation education to prospective buyers in Harris County. Focuses on financial readiness, credit awareness, budgeting, understanding mortgage options, and navigating the home purchasing process. Participants also receive guidance on working with lenders and realtors, including key steps in making informed decisions toward sustainable homeownership.


